

This step will allow the Cowley County Extension Council Finance Committee to review all submissions to provide insight and suggestions. This also insures that the 4-H clover is used appropriately and non-discrimination/equal opportunity components exist. There are also situations where funds might have to be processed through Kansas State University.

If your club or project leaders are considering grant applications or extra funding sources, please submit in writing a copy of the grant application to the 4-H Agent at least 5 business days prior to the grant deadline. We encourage creativity in fundraising and applaud the efforts of groups seeking external funding sources.
